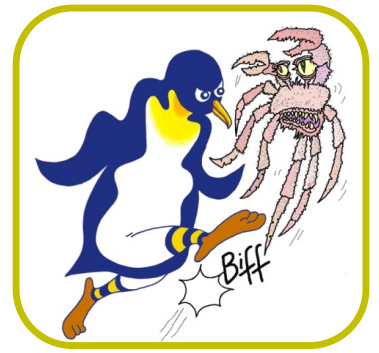

Any unused or unspent funds are to be returned to PAC.
- You must inform PAC as soon as possible if there is any delay in the proposed start date of the project.

PAC is a registered charity which raises awareness of cancer, and makes grants to support cancer research, treatment and hospices. PAC is staffed entirely by volunteers and has no running costs.
