Dear St Luke's Hospice,

We are electronically transferring a Grant of £5 000 from Penguins Against Cancer (PAC) to you, to be used to provide palliative care in your excellent institution. This is in addition to the £5000 Grants we sent you in May 2026, October 2025, June 2025, August 2024, February 2024 and May 2023. This has been proposed by Pete Davis and Charlie Beardmore, and is in memory of Emma Lancashire, who we would like you to acknowledge as the inspiration behind this Grant. Emma was Rob Lancashire's wife, a hugely talented Paediatric Anaesthetist at Derriford hospital. Rob, who has raised a large amount of money for PAC, has stated as we have mentioned previously: 'St Luke's is a brilliant institution. Emma's final days there were as comfortable as possible in a haven away from home. The staff were phenomenal – I did not know anyone could be that kind. It is an amazing place.'

This Grant was made possible following hugely successful fundraising by the 32 strong Penguin Peloton, ranging in age from 18 to 63, on their cycle ride from Windsor Castle to Guy's Hospital via South Wales over 4 days from 1st to 4th May 2026. Pete and Charlie were present throughout the event. The Peloton cycled 360 miles with nearly 4500m of ascent.

PAC exists to raise cancer awareness, and to provide support to cancer research and treatment, as well as to hospices. It has no running or administrative expenses (all costs being met by individual PAC Members) and has many students studying at Guy's Hospital (6 of whom were in the Penguin Peloton) as active supporters.
