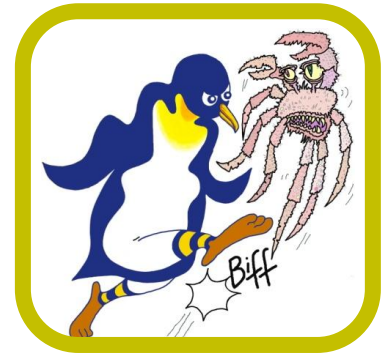

Dear Urology Foundation,

We are electronically transferring a Grant for £35,000 from Penguins Against Cancer (PAC) to you specifically to be used to fund research into treatments to combat urological cancers. £5,000 of this should be used as PAC's contribution to the Chris Howell Urological Cancer Research Award (jointly funded with TUF) and £10,000 of it should be used to as PAC's contribution to the Small Projects Research Initiative (jointly funded with TUF) please. This grant is in addition to the £30,000 grant we sent you in June 2025, the £5,000 grant we sent you in May 2025, the £5,000 grant we sent you in July 2024, the £25,000 grant we sent you in April 2024, the £5,000 grant we sent you in February 2024, the £25,000 grant we sent you in May 2023, the £25,000 grant we sent you in September 2022, the £10,000 grant we sent you in July 2021, the £3,000 grant we sent you in November 2020, the £3,000 grant we sent you in March 2020, the £2,000 grant we sent you in July 2017, the £1,000 grant we sent to you in December 2015, and the £2,000 grant we sent to you in January 2014.

This grant was proposed by Ben Challacombe and Charlie Beardmore, both PAC Trustees, and is made in direct support of Professor Stephen Challacombe, Chris Howell and Chris Gould, who we would like you to formally acknowledge as the inspirations behind the Grant. It was made possible following hugely successful fundraising by the 32 strong Penguin Peloton, ranging in age from 18 to 63, on their cycle ride from Windsor Castle to Guy's Hospital via South Wales over 4 days from 1st to 4th May 2026, in which Ben and Charlie both participated. They cycled 360 miles with nearly 4500m of ascent.

PAC exists to raise cancer awareness, and to provide support to cancer research and treatment, as well as to hospices. It has no running or administrative expenses (all costs being met by individual PAC Members) and has many students studying at Guy's Hospital (6 of whom were in the Penguin Peloton) as active supporters.
