This award will support our investigation into whether abbreviated MRI may offer an alternative to full protocol MRI for monitoring response to neoadjuvant chemotherapy in breast cancer patients. Full protocol MRI is currently the gold standard however it is time consuming and for some patients, can be difficult to tolerate. In other settings, abbreviated MRI is quicker and has proven to be as accurate as full protocol MRI. Our research aims to investigate whether this is also the case for monitoring response to neoadjuvant chemotherapy.

Your support has provided us with the opportunity to recruit a research technician, a post which is currently being advertised, to collect and prepare retrospective MRI and supporting data for assessment and reporting. In addition, we are in the process of acquiring ethical approval for this work.
