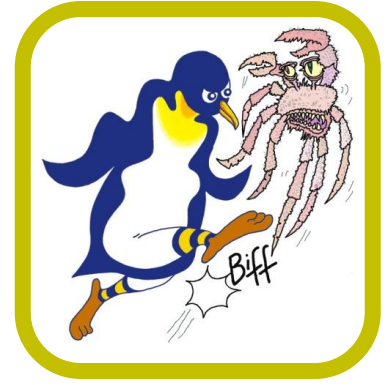

We are electronically transferring a Grant of £6,000 from Penguins Against Cancer (PAC) to you, specifically to be used to support research into treatment options for head and neck cancers. This is in addition to the £2,000 Grant we sent you in December 2017. This grant was proposed by Charlie and Pat Gush, both longstanding Trustees of PAC, and is in direct support of Neil Shah, an oral cancer survivor and Oral and Maxillofacial surgeon who you know well. We would like you to acknowledge Neil as the inspiration behind this Grant.

PAC exists to raise cancer awareness, and to provide support to cancer research and treatment, as well as to hospices. It has no running or administrative expenses (all costs being met by individual PAC Members) and has many students studying at Guy's Hospital as active supporters, a number of whom are particularly keen to support the work that you do.
