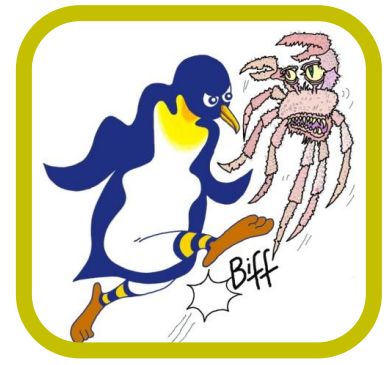

Dear Pancreatic Cancer UK,

We are electronically transferring a Grant of £5 000 from Penguins Against Cancer (PAC) to you, to be used to fund innovative research into treatments for Pancreatic Cancer. This is in addition to the £10,000 grant we sent you in June 2025, the £5,000 grant we sent you in August 2024, the £5,000 grant we sent you in November 2023, the £5,000 grant we sent you in May 2023, the £5,000 grant we sent you in September 2022, the £5,000 grant we sent to you in November 2021, and the £7,000 grant we sent you in September 2015. This has been proposed by Charlotte and Charlie Beardmore, and is in memory of Ron Spedding, Jean Davis and Simon Lau, who we would like you to acknowledge as the inspirations behind this Grant. Charlie Gush (Ron's daughter) and Pete Davis (Jean's son) are both very active PAC Trustees and have contributed enormously to the charity over many years. The Lau family are also strong supporters of PAC.

This Grant was made possible following hugely successful fundraising by the 32 strong Penguin Peloton, ranging in age from 18 to 63, on their cycle ride from Windsor Castle to Guy's Hospital via South Wales over 4 days from 1st to 4th May 2026. The Peloton cycled over 570 km with nearly 4500m of ascent and Pete was an invaluable support driver throughout.

PAC exists to raise cancer awareness, and to provide support to cancer research and treatment, as well as to hospices. It has no running or administrative expenses (all costs being met by individual PAC Members) and has many students studying at Guy's Hospital (6 of whom were cycling in the Penguin Peloton) as active supporters.
