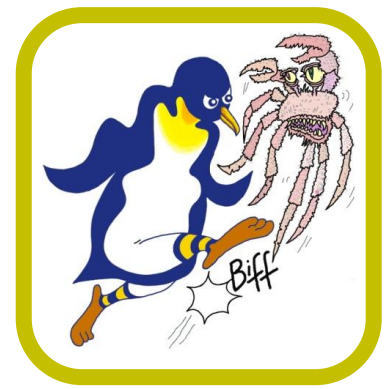

Dear Pancreatic Cancer UK, We enclose a grant of £5,000 from Penguins Against Cancer (PAC) to you, to be used to fund innovative research into treatments for Pancreatic Cancer. This is in addition to the £5 000 grant we sent you in May 2023, the £5,000 grant we sent you in September 2022, the £5,000 grant we sent to you in November 2021, and the £7,000 grant we sent you in September 2015.

Penguins Against Cancer (PAC) is a registered charity set up to raise awareness of cancer and to provide support to cancer research and treatment, and hospices. PAC is run purely by unpaid volunteers and has zero running costs. This latest grant was made possible by the continuing generosity of our supporters, particularly during our 10th Anniversary Ball held in London earlier this month.

PAC continues to stage numerous sporting and social events, with the aim of making altruism fun. We plan to take 40 riders on a sponsored cycle ride by the Penguin Peloton from Guy's Hospital Tower, Bermondsey to Blackpool Tower, Lancashire, some 250 miles, in May 2024.
