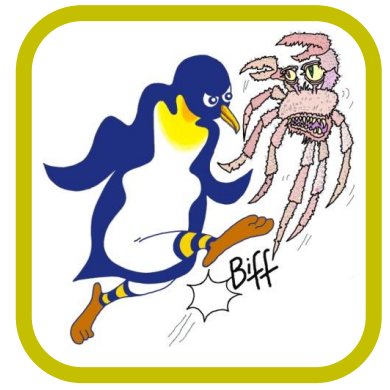

Dear Lymphoma Action,

We are writing to you enclosing a cheque for **£5,000** as a grant from Penguins Against Cancer (PAC) to you, specifically to be used to raise awareness of lymphoma and to provide support directly to those affected by lymphoma. This grant is in addition to the £5,000 grant we sent you in April 2024, the £5,000 grant in May 2023, the £2,000 grant in August 2020, the £4,000 grant in January 2020 and the £1,000 grant to Lymphoma Association sent by PAC in November 2016.

This grant was proposed by Louise Aaron and Charlie Beardmore, both longstanding PAC Trustees and is in direct support of Zac Baxter, a Guys Hospital graduate. Zac underwent postgraduate medical training with Louise and was diagnosed with non-Hodgkin lymphoma earlier this year. We would therefore like you to acknowledge Zac, who has recently got married, as the inspiration behind this grant.

PAC exists to raise cancer awareness, and to provide support to cancer research and treatment, as well as to hospices. It has no running or administrative expenses (all costs being met by individual PAC Members) and has many students studying at Guy's Hospital as active supporters. This Grant has been made possible following the enormous generosity of our supporters, particularly the Penguin Peloton, a mixture of students and many older Penguins, ranging in age from 18 to 66, who cycled over 250 miles from Guys Hospital to Blackpool over 3 days earlier this year to raise funds for PAC.
