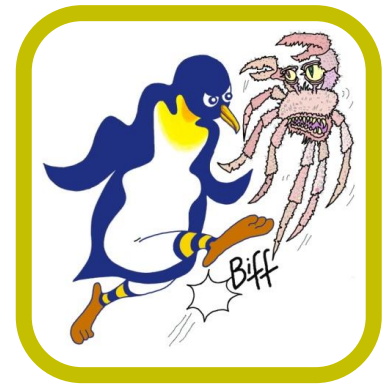

Dear Princess Alice Hospice,

We enclose a grant for **£5,000** from Penguins Against Cancer (PAC) to you, to be used to provide palliative care in your excellent institution. This is in addition to the £5,000 grant made to you by PAC in Apr 2019 and the £1,000 grants in January and July 2014, and July 2015.

PAC is a registered charity which raises awareness of cancer, and makes grants to support cancer research, treatment and hospices. This latest grant, proposed by Geraint Thomason, has been made possible following the outstanding success of the recent Penguin Peloton 'Tower to Tower' [T3] bike ride from Guy's Hospital to Spinnaker Tower, Portsmouth which saw 16 Penguins, with a combined age in excess of 850 years, accompanied by 2 Black Cat support crew, complete nearly 100 miles of cycling. Thus far over £29,000 has been raised, including outstandingly generous support from Lord Kirkham's Foundation.

Our fundraising, sporting and social activities have been somewhat curtailed by COVID-19 but PAC remains vibrant, optimistic and forward-looking, not least due to the huge altruism demonstrated by our student members.
