

Dear Anthea,

Nicola Wright has been in touch with Charlie Gush, one of our Trustees, about your excellent work and, sadly, how the pandemic has greatly affected your fundraising and events. We therefore enclose a grant (cheque no 134) of **£3,600** from Penguins against Cancer (PAC) to support Richard House Children's Hospice, specifically to assist with provision of terminal care to children. PAC is a registered charity which raises awareness of cancer, and makes grants to support cancer research, treatment and hospices.

This latest grant has been made possible following the outstanding success of the recent Penguin Peloton 'Tower to Tower' [T3] bike ride from Guy's Hospital to Spinnaker Tower, Portsmouth which saw 16 Penguins, with a combined age in excess of 850 years, accompanied by 2 Black Cat support crew, complete nearly 100 miles of cycling. Thus far, over £29,000 has been raised from this event, including outstandingly generous support from Lord Kirkham's Foundation.

PAC was established in 2013 and our aim is simply to combat cancer. We have raised and disbursed over £220,000 already in grants to support cancer research and treatment, as well as to hospices. PAC has no start-up or running costs. Our founders were drawn from Guy's Hospital Penguins, the oldest team in the oldest rugby club in the world.
