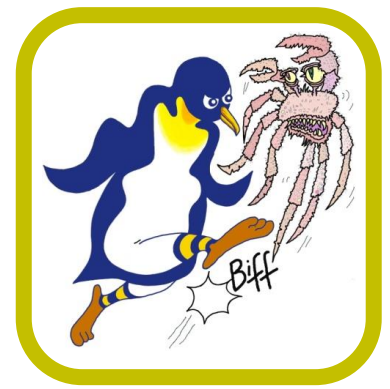

Dear Urology Foundation,

Please find enclosed a cheque for **£25,000** as a grant to you from Penguins Against Cancer (PAC), to be used to fund research into treatments to combat urological cancers. This follows the £25,000 grant we sent you in September 2022, the £10,000 grant we sent you in July 2021, the £3,000 grant we sent you in November 2020, the £3,000 grant we sent you in March 2020, the £2,000 grant we sent you in July 2017, the £1,000 grant we sent to you in December 2015, and the £2,000 grant we sent to you in January 2014.

Penguins Against Cancer (PAC) is a registered charity set up to raise awareness of cancer and to provide support to cancer research and treatment, and hospices. PAC is run purely by unpaid volunteers and has zero running costs. PAC continues to stage numerous sporting and social events, with the aim of making altruism fun. This particular grant has been made possible following the recent Bermondsey to Bruges sponsored cycle ride by the Penguin Peloton of 28 riders, ranging in age from 16 to 61, which raised over £50,000 for PAC.
