
The aim of the Pancreatic Cancer UK Research Innovation Fund is to spur creative and cutting edge ideas and approaches in pancreatic cancer research, including those successful in other areas of cancer research that have justifiable promise for pancreatic cancer. The one year awards are intended to support pilot work that will lead to larger scale project or programme grant applications.

We believe our support of pioneering, individual research grants (up to £75,000 for each grant) will make a significant difference in a disease area where little progress has been made in the last 40 years.

Our current research innovation grants are split into three areas: early diagnosis, personalised treatment and improving the chances of treatment success.
