
This bursary will be used to support Danielle's work on the METAL trial - (**MET**formin **A**nd **L**ongevity): *A window of opportunity study investigating biological effects of metformin in localised prostate cancer* - which aims to investigate the anti-cancer effects of the diabetes drug metformin on prostate cancer tissue. Thanks to the hard work of your supporters we will be able to collect and store additional blood and serum samples for each METAL patient, allowing us to perform further translational studies on the patients enrolled in the study.

Danielle herself completed her PhD in late November 2017 and is now on maternity leave after the birth of her third little girl. She will re-join the TOUR team in January 2019 as a Chadburn Lecturer in Cancer Epidemiology.
