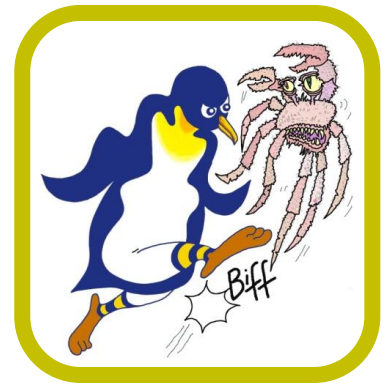


PENGUINS AGAINST CANCER
