These awards are made for research which seeks to improve an aspect of urological treatment or care, and which would have a direct impact on patient outcomes and wellbeing.

In fact you may have read about the study in the donor update I sent to you via email yesterday and which, embarrassingly, crossed with your donation. The study, to be conducted by a collaborative of urology trainees, is looking at how to improve diagnosis of testicular torsion without resorting to potentially unnecessary and costly surgery, with a view to also creating a teaching module for general and urological surgery.
