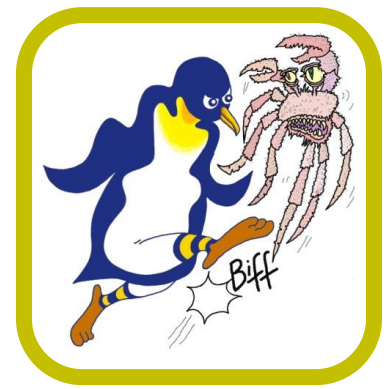

Please find enclosed a cheque for £2,000 for your Melanoma Research Fund from Penguins Against Cancer, a charity set up to raise awareness of cancer and to provide support to cancer research and treatment organisations, and hospices. This follows the £1,000 grant we sent you in June 2014.
