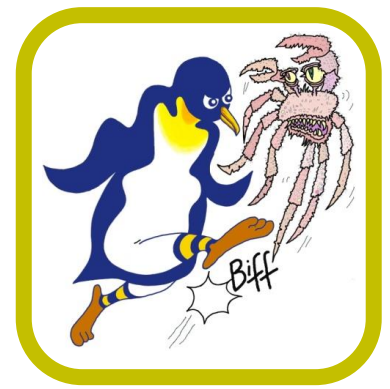

We enclose a grant of **£5,000** from Penguins Against Cancer to you, to be used to provide palliative care in your excellent institution. This is in addition to the £3,000 we sent you in September 2022, the £5,000 we sent you in April 2019, the £5,000 we sent you in November 2017, the £1,000 we sent you in July 2015, and the £2,000 we sent you in September 2014. This grant, proposed by Pat and Charlie Gush, and Paul and Tanya Harwood is in memory of Stephen Knight. It was made possible by the continuing generosity of our supporters.

Penguins Against Cancer (PAC) is a registered charity set up to raise awareness of cancer and to provide support to cancer research and treatment, and hospices. PAC is run purely by unpaid volunteers and has zero running costs. PAC continues to stage numerous sporting and social events, with the aim of making altruism fun. We plan to take 28 riders on a sponsored cycle ride by the Penguin Peloton from Guy's Hospital Tower, Bermondsey to the Bruges Clock Tower, Belgium, some 200 miles, in April this year.
