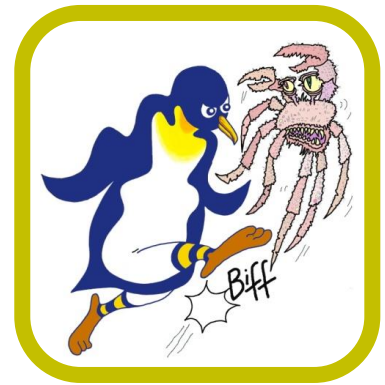

Please find enclosed a cheque for £2,000 as a grant to you, from Penguins Against Cancer, a registered charity set up to raise awareness of cancer and support cancer research and treatment, and hospices. This follows the £1,000 grant we sent to Breakthrough Breast Cancer in May 2014.
