This promoted significant discussion on how to both recruit more Members and to encourage Supporters to convert to being Members. Membership subscriptions are a minimum of £1 per month There was welcome discussion from a number of students regarding how they could get more closely involved in the running of PAC events. A proposal was raised by Sami Lewis to invite recently qualified members to join the PAC student council (currently the council has 3 x female student members and 3 x male student members). Aminah Chowdhury also made some suggestions on how the process of joining PAC could be streamlined by for example looking at the PATRION payment system with respect to collecting membership subscriptions. A number of other suggestions were made such as inviting the Student Council members to attend Trustees meetings. The President agreed to discuss these suggestions with the other Trustees to try to move the issues forward.
