Your funds will help support research that will improve the quality and duration of life for myeloma patients. One example of this is the Myeloma UK Clinical Trial Network (CTN) that was established in 2009 with eight hospitals across the UK and was designed to link hospitals together to work more efficiently and to conduct prioritised and strategic clinical trials. These trials give myeloma patients early access to novel drugs that are not yet approved for use on the NHS. The ultimate goal of the CTN is for the data from these trials to ensure that new treatments are approved for patients on the NHS.

Thanks to supporters like you, our CTN has now expanded to 28 hospitals, which means more patients are getting access to the most promising new treatments.
