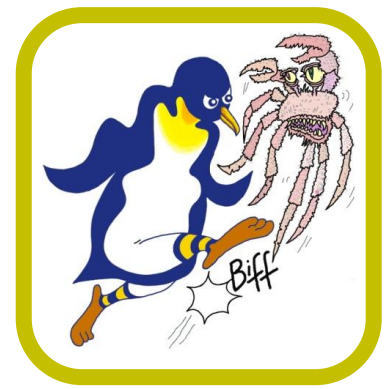

Please find enclosed a cheque for **£5,000** as a grant from our charity, Penguins Against Cancer (PAC), to you to be used to raise awareness of lymphoma and provide support to those affected by lymphoma. This grant is given in recognition of the wonderful support you provide to those suffering from lymphatic cancer and is specifically in memory of Tim Bates who succumbed to the disease some 26 years ago. This is in addition to the £2,000 grant we sent you in August 2020, the £4,000 grant that Penguins Against Cancer made to Lymphoma Action in January 2020 and the £1,000 grant to Lymphoma Association by us in November 2016. Tim's wife, Margaret Littlejohns, has been involved with Lymphoma Action / Lymphoma Association for many years and is the sister of one of our founding Trustees, David Littlejohns. David is also the Webmaster and Marketing Officer for our charity.

This latest grant was made possible following the recent Bermondsey to Bruges sponsored cycle ride by the Penguin Peloton of 28 riders, ranging in age from 16 to 61, which raised over £50,000 for PAC.
