4	Financial Position: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Treasurer produced a very clear report (attached). • It was noted that cheque no 115 for £3000 to the Urology Foundation, dated 24 Feb 20, had still not been cashed. Ben Challacombe agreed to contact the Urology Foundation (TUF) and ascertain the cause of the delay. Afternote: The cheque has been received and acknowledged but not yet cashed due to COVID-19 restrictions (Explanatory TUF letter on PAC website under THANKS) • The Treasurer will draft a £5000 cheque, made out to Institute of Cancer Research (ICR), for the Fergus Fund Grant 2019, which has been awarded to Dr Sally George, c/o Prof Louis Chesler, Paediatric Solid Tumour Biology Team, ICR. Sally's research is focussed on the identification of PARPi resistance mechanisms in ATRX mutant neuroblastoma to guide novel combination strategies. • The President will contact ICR to inform them that the cheque will shortly be sent to them [a congratulatory letter to Sally has already been sent] • The assembled Trustees voted unanimously to replace Anita Combes, as a PAC bank account authorised signatory, with Alex Schaub, as soon as practicable. Grants During is accounting period (April 2019 – April 2020) we have made a total of £43,900 in Grants to support the objectives of the charity. All the grants have been cashed apart from the grant to the Urology Foundation for £3,000.

Our accounting period ended on 6th April 2020 so I will start to produce the yearly accounts.

I wrote a cheque to Breast Cancer Now (Cheque 113) for £11,900 but it bounced at the bank as it only had two signatures on it. In order to write a cheque over £10,000 we need to have three signatures. Thus, I have reissued the cheque (Cheque 114) which was signed by three people and has successfully been cashed.

We continue to support the Fergus Fund £5000 as discussed at the last trustees meeting. The last cheque was written in May 2019. See Simon's discussion on the Fergus Fund.

The balance of our account this morning was £10,836 but the Urology Foundation Cheque £3,000 has yet to be cashed.

Thus our available balance is £7,836.
