

Dear Lady McAdden Team,

We are writing to you enclosing a cheque for £3,000 as a grant from Penguins Against Cancer (PAC) to you, specifically to be used to directly support the BUST, breast cancer screening unit. This grant was proposed by Charlie Spedding and Pat Gush, who are both Trustees and founder members of PAC. The grant has been made possible by some excellent fundraising efforts by our members, not least at the recent Scanlan Memorial Cup rugby match, where the Penguin XV overcame a spirited Guy's Hospital Student XV to retain this iconic piece of silverware.

Of note, Paul Scanlan played for Guy's 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th XV's from 1984 to 1993 and was a founder member of the Penguins XV. He qualified in Dentistry in 1989 and was the first of his year to achieve Consultant status, as an orthodontist working in SE London and Kent. His irrepressible humour, energy and zest for living were tragically curtailed by an acute illness which rapidly took his life. He remains sorely missed and is remembered by the annual Penguins v Student XV match played for the Scanlan Cup.

PAC exists to raise cancer awareness, and to provide support to cancer research and treatment, as well as to hospices. It has no running or administrative costs and has a large number of students studying at Guy's Hospital as Members.
